Why the talk is inspiring?

The prognoses are that by 2050 approximately 70% of the world's population will live in urbanized areas, i.e. cities. Considering the fact that about 90% of the world's largest cities are situated on the waterfront, we have arrived to a situation where we are forced to rethink how we should live together with water. The unpredictability of future stimulates us to come up with flexible strategies and plan changes. Remko van Buren imagines future city as a mobile and floating vast territories capable of outsmarting ever changing water level and not leaving any scars to earth. According to the speaker, this is a tangible solution to urbanisation problems.
